Dear Customers,

We have had many questions over the past few days regarding what the time frame for the new pump installation would be and what you, as a customer should do in order to be prepared.

It is my sincere wish that the following will answer any questions that you have regarding the days to come.

February 8th- Conserve Water Notice

What does this mean? Due to the limited water in the water tank, we are asking all customers on Mexia Water System to please **CONSERVE** water. During this time, use the water for **ONLY WHAT YOU NEED**.

- Refrain from running your dishwasher or washing clothes at this time.
- Turn off the faucet while brushing your teeth.
- Utilize a low-water usage shower, when possible, do not run the shower full blast nor fill up your bathtub all the way.
- Drink bottled water when possible

February 9th- Boil Water Notice

What does this mean? Due to the nature of the work being done on the well, this work carries potential contamination or other organisms that could enter the distribution system should the system drop below 20 psi. During this time, **BOIL** your water before using for consumption.

- **DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST.** Bring all water to a rolling boil for at least (3) three minutes, and let it cool before using, or use bottled water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, and food preparation until further notice. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water. **ALL STORED WATER, DRINK OR ICE MADE RECENTLY FROM THIS SUPPLY SHOULD BE DISCARDED.**
- It is advisable to **BOIL** water for your pets.
- Adults **DO NOT HAVE TO BOIL WATER FOR BATHING OR SHOWERING-** however, if you have young children, please monitor them to ensure they do not consume any water while bathing.
- Flushing toilets and washing clothes is permissible during this time.

As soon as we receive notification of satisfactory bacteriological sample testing results, we will lift the boil water notice and you will be able to resume your regular water usage.

All of us at Mexia Water System, encourage each of you to always veer on the side of caution.
